

Cushendall & Cushendun Camping Cabin Rules 2014

Occupancy

Camping Cabins are to hold a family of four, with a maximum of 2 adults. Children under 10 are to be counted as a ½. The Warden has the right to use their discretion in this matter.

Noise

11pm-9am is quite time.

Musical Instruments, stereos, singing and other similar sources of noise are strictly prohibited after 11pm, and during the day must be kept to a level so as not to disturb other park users.

Parents are responsible for ensuring their children are quite after 11pm and not disturbing other park users.

Anyone sitting outdoors after 11pm are asked to keep their voices low and to respect their neighbours right to peace and quite and we ask that you move indoors after 12midnight.

Dogs

Dogs are to be kept under proper control and leashed at all times whilst on the site. All foul must be bagged and binned and no dog is allowed in the communal buildings or camping cabins. (Guide and service dogs excepted.)

The Warden will ask that any dog proving to be a nuisance to be removed from the site.

Fire Risks

No smoking, cooking or naked flames are permitted in the camping cabins or on the decking areas at any time. A picnic table has been provided with a metal plate for those who wish to use disposable BBQs etc.

The use of chimeraes and fire pits are permitted provided they are a suitable distance from any combustible surface and are properly extinguished before retiring for the night.

Open fires are not permitted at any time.

Ball Games

No 'leather' balls are permitted on the park i.e. Football, Rugby, Hurling etc. Tennis balls and soft plastic balls are permitted.

Breakages

All breakages of the parks fixtures and fittings must be reported immediately to the park Warden.

Arrival/Departures

Arrival to the cabins are permitted from 2.00pm (Cushendun Caravan Park only) or 5pm (Cushendall Caravan Park) onwards, cabins are to be vacated by 12noon on the day of departure.

The Wardens interpretation is final. Anyone found breaking any of the above may be asked to leave the park immediately.
